RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Sharing your faith in Jesus Christ and praying with shelter guests, volunteers and co-workers as opportunities arise.
- Attending to all discipleship needs by supervising guests and providing physical, emotional and spiritual assistance as appropriate.
- Maintaining order and cleanliness of discipleship facilities, performing housekeeping duties as needed.
- Supervising discipleship men; planning and overseeing general day-to-day activities while ensuring correct procedures and proper mission standards are followed.
- Teaching Bible study lessons and life skills
- Transporting Discipleship Program guests to and from appointments as needed, using mission van.
- Maintaining security of shelter, including performing room checks and security rounds.
- Supervising meals and preparation of meals in cook's absence.
- Assisting Discipleship Program Manager in planning group outings and events.
- Assisting with the Discipleship Program intake process.
- Any other tasks assigned by supervisor.

PRIMARY STRENGTHS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Must be a mature, born-again Christian and be in fellowship with a local evangelical church.
- Must desire to serve men in meeting their physical needs and discipling them in their Christian faith.
- Must provide a clear biblical testimony of a personal experience of receiving by faith the Lord Jesus Christ as Savior and give evidence of His presence in daily living. Must desire to serve the Lord in the ministry of rescue.
- Must be a high school graduate, college graduate preferred.
- Previous history working in a residential rehabilitation environment preferred.
- Must subscribe to the bylaws and statement of faith of the organization.
- Must possess excellent verbal and written communication skills and be able to effectively communicate with guests, team members, volunteers and community organizations.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Part-time hourly position
- Hours: 24/week with rotating weekend shifts required
- Must have a valid Michigan driver's license with a clean driving record, along with current vehicle insurance.
- Flexibility in hours may be necessary to meet Mission needs.
