Facilitate conflict resolution between the guests and others, with an aim towards restoration. The Community Navigator will establish individual goals and plans for each guest to help them succeed in society. Must maintain confidentiality of files, family dynamics, and details, including case specifics. Trustworthiness is key in this role.

You're A Great Communicator

Your ability to communicate clearly and effectively with others helps you encourage shelter guests and team members. You will establish appropriate boundaries. Support and enforce disciplinary policies for shelter guests.

You Care About People

Actions and words demonstrate a genuine commitment to making a positive difference in the lives of others, driven by empathy, compassion, and a strong sense of responsibility. You are an active listener and use your resources to guide others to a brighter future.

You're Organized

You are great at multitasking and adapting as needed. You possess the ability to manage time, tasks, and resources effectively, resulting in improved productivity, reduced stress, and better outcomes for the team and our guests.

You're Strong in Your Faith

Sharing the love of Jesus Christ is at the heart of this position. Your job is to communicate the Gospel and model Christian character. Are you prepared to share your testimony?
